





The training focuses on problematic and topical issues of finance, banking and insurance, practical training of applicants for higher education, creation of information and educational content to stimulate self-education of applicants, project activities to develop teamwork skills and independent search for solutions to problematic issues.</p> <p>Lectures, seminars, labs, individual research assignments, independent work, counseling. The training is discussion-based and practical (workshops, business games, presentations, discussions, problem-solving, joint consultations, etc.) and takes place in the form of team interaction (in groups, small groups).</p> <p>The pedagogical and methodical support and counseling of independent work is provided by the University information and educational environment MOODLE – a system of CLMS software products, the distribution of which is free according to the principles of the Open-Source license.</p> <p>Information support for the participation of applicants in competitions for scholarships, awards, grants (including international ones); support for the participation of applicants for higher education in student scientific competitions and contests.</p>

	<p>The current control is carried out during practical and seminar classes, it is aimed at checking the level of readiness of the applicant for higher education to perform a specific job. Modular control is performed after studying the programme material of each content module.</p> <p>The form of the module control (tests, written tests, colloquium, quantifiable experimental results, calculation or calculation-graphic work, etc.) is chosen by the lecturer of academic subject. After conducting a module control in all content modules and determining their evaluation scores, the lecturer of academic subject determines the applicant's overall evaluation in academic work.</p> <p>The final control includes the semester control and the certification of the applicants for higher education. An applicant for higher education is admitted to the semester control if he or she has completed all the types of work and assignments provided for the relevant academic subject in the semester curriculum. Semester control in the form of an examination or a credit in a particular academic subject is regulated by the Regulations on the Organization of the Educational Process at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University, the Regulations on the Control and Assessment of Academic Achievement of Applicants for Higher Education at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University.</p> <p>Certification of applicants for higher education in the educational programme is carried out in the form of a comprehensive examination in the subject area and a public defense of the qualification work.</p> <p>The procedure for certification of applicants for higher education is conducted in accordance with the “Regulations on Final Qualification Works (new edition)” and the “Regulations on the Procedure for Establishing and Organizing the Work of the Examination Commission at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University (new edition)”.</p>

V. Forms of certification of applicants for higher education

The final assessment of higher education applicants of an educational-professional programme is regulated by the “Regulation on Graduation Qualification Works at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”, “Regulation on the Organization of the Educational Process at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”, “Regulation on the European Credit Transfer System at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”, “Regulations on the Procedure of Establishing and Organizing the Work of the Examination Commission at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”, and other normative legal acts.

The certification of higher education applicants of an educational programme is carried out in the forms of the comprehensive examination on a specialty and a public defense of the qualification paper and concludes with the issuance of a document of the established pattern conferring the master's degree in Finance, Banking, Insurance, and Stock Market.

The qualification paper should involve solving a complex problem in the field of finance, banking, insurance, and stock market that requires research and/or innovation, characterized by complexity and uncertainty of conditions.

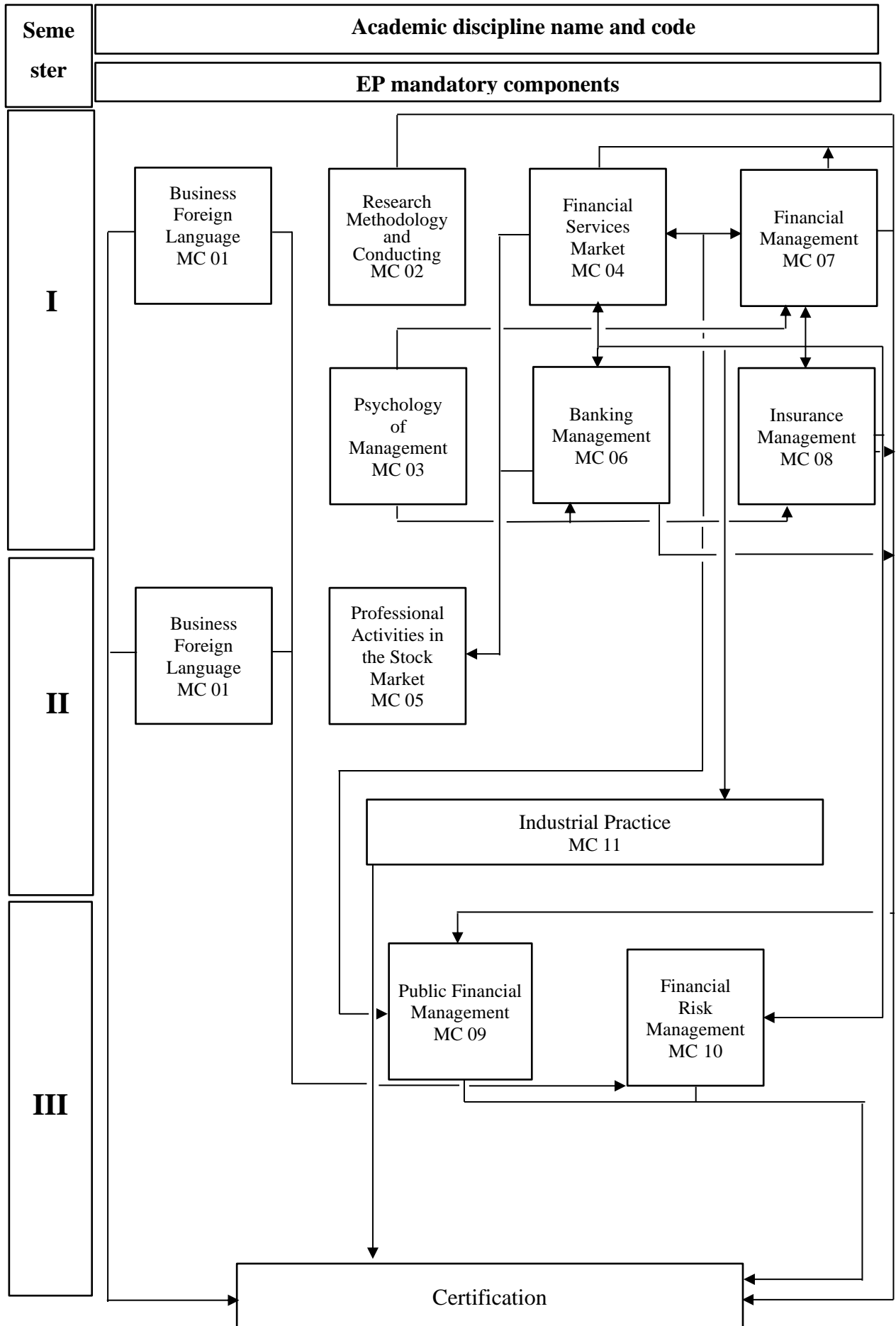
Prior to the defense, qualification papers undergo mandatory plagiarism checks. It is not allowed to defend papers that have not been written independently and have not been checked for academic plagiarism (“Regulations on the Prevention and Detection of Academic Plagiarism at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”).

The qualification paper should be published on the official website of the Institute of Economy and Business Education of Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University.

The requirements for the scope, content and structure of the qualification paper are determined by the “Regulations on Qualification Papers at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”.

The certification is conducted openly and publicly.

VII. Requirements for an internal education quality assurance system

The system of internal higher education quality assurance at the University is created and operates on the basis of the following principles: academic freedom, autonomy and self-regulation; openness to new knowledge and criticism; honesty and tolerance towards team members and partners; mutual challenge and trust; initiative and leadership; social and individual responsibility for the results of work; inclusiveness of the educational environment.

The system of internal higher education quality assurance at the University provides for the implementation of the following procedures and measures:

- Establishment of principles and procedures for ensuring higher education quality;
- Monitoring and periodic review of the educational programmes;
- Annual evaluation of applicants for higher education, research and teaching staff of the University and regular publication of evaluation results on the official website, information stands, etc.;
- Continuing education for research and teaching staff;
- Ensuring the availability of necessary resources for organizing the educational process for each educational program;
- Ensuring the availability of information systems for effective management of the educational process;
- Ensuring the publicity of information on educational programmes, degrees and qualifications;
- Ensuring academic integrity of University employees and applicants for higher education by creating and ensuring the functioning of an effective system for preventing and detecting academic plagiarism.

The structure of the system of internal higher education quality assurance at the University is formed by the University community: structural units, research and teaching staff, students, representatives of the administration and support services.

There are five levels of the University's internal higher education quality assurance system.

Procedures and measures to ensure education quality at the University are regulated by the “Regulations on the Organization of the Educational Process at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”, “Regulations on Educational Programs at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”, “Regulations on the System of Internal Higher Education Quality Assurance at Pavlo Tychyna Uman State Pedagogical University”, etc.
